Dear Friends of the Animals:

I'm willing to bet that you feel the same as I do, and that you also love the cover of this issue of Pawprint, PHS/SPCA's quarterly membership magazine. Those are nine beautiful faces (yes, even the Chinese Water Dragon: lizards need love too!), nine of the beautiful faces of the more than 6,500 beautiful animals we are on target to save in 2011.

Throughout the year, PHS/SPCA is caring for and seeking new homes for a few dozen small animals.

But speaking of numbers, please don't worry. Even if a picture is worth a thousand words, I am not going to attempt nine thousand words here. No, just a few words about the thousands of faces we see.

Like the face of that big, tan dog with the chocolate brown eyes. He arrived severely injured in a car accident, a stray dog in the wrong place at the wrong time. No collar, no tag, no microchip, and sad to say no one looking for him, but with a broken leg, severe "road burns" from where his body was dragged along the asphalt, and terribly frightened. Our veterinarians healed his body, our behaviorists healed his spirits, and a few weeks in the home of one of our volunteer foster families completed the recovery of both. This *Hope Program* success is now in the loving embrace of his new forever family. One of the more than 6,500 faces we have met and who we will love this year.

The face of that tiny, ping pong ball size of a kitten. Just a few weeks old, too young to be away from her mother, too young to be on her own, she is just one of the so many homeless and underage kittens who will come to us this year. Many also go to our foster families, but she is one of those selected for special care here in our first-of-its-kind kitten nursery. Cared for by a combination of our professional veterinary medical staff and a special cadre of nursery volunteers, she and her nursery roommates will find human surrogates playing



National Animal Control Employee of the Year

Jeff Christner, manager of PHS/SPCA's Animal Rescue & Control Department, has been named the 2010 National Animal Control Association (NACA) Employee of the Year. Jeff's nomination was considered along with other employees from across the United States. In the nomination letter, Jeff was recognized for his role leading PHS/SPCA's response to the horrific gas explosion in San Bruno, his successful efforts ensuring PHS/SPCA's ability to safely handle rescues of large animals such as horses, and his overall dedication to his work, employees and the organization.

"This is an incredible honor for Jeff," said PHS/SPCA President Ken White. "Animal Control work, when done compassionately and efficiently, is among a community's real assets since so many people care for or about animals. We're fortunate to have Jeff leading our teams who rescue animals from harm's way and investigate acts of cruelty."

In his current role as department manager, he oversees our contracted field work and our donor-supported investigations.

Since its very early days as a private humane society, PHS/SPCA has been contracted by the county and its cities to perform state-mandated animal control work, which includes rescue and sheltering of stray animals. PHS/SPCA has maintained this role for nearly six decades, ensuring the best possible service for local residents and their animals.

Immediate Response for Abused Animals

PHS/SPCA employs trained investigators who respond to animal neglect and abuse. They show owners how they can make simple changes to improve their pets' lives and occasionally order immediate veterinary care. In the worst cases, PHS/SPCA takes custody of animals and files cruelty reports with our District Attorney's Office. Our Doors Remain Open for All Animals, Especially the Neediest

Accepting all animals has remained a PHS/SPCA hallmark for decades. It's often how we define ourselves, right after "private, independent non-profit." As an open-door shelter, PHS/SPCA accepts all animals at all times, regardless of their age, size, breed, medical condition or temperament. We accept all the owner-surrendered and stray animals who are perfectly healthy and need nothing more than a new home. We accept all the treatable animals, too, who need medical care or behavior work before they can be made available for adoption. This work is as varied as the animals we receive; it may include a surgery, a course of medications, grooming and dental work, or one-on-one work with a member of our Behavior Department to address a challenging behavior such as severe shyness or lack of basic doggie manners. Sadly, for a small number of animals, there is no amount of work that can make them better; these animals are always made available to

rescue groups, but they can't help them either. PHS/SPCA maintains this open-door position, even though we know it is much more difficult than being a limited-admission or so-called no-kill shelter which maintains that status only by choosing to accept just those animals who can be easily and quickly rehomed with little or none of the behind-the-scenes work. Essentially, PHS/SPCA does all the work of a no-kill shelter (since we find homes for 100% of the healthy dogs and cats in our care), but goes much further. We accept treatable animals who would otherwise be turned away at limited admission shelters; we use donor-supported programs to make them better, then find new homes. We currently find a few thousand homes every year for these Hope Program animals. Having an open-door is challenging, costly, and often emotional. It's also rewarding and what we feel is most "right" for our community and its animals.



In their Prime...

PHS/SPCA regularly has a number of cats we are surprised to see overlooked for so long. Since many people love kittens, they are placed into new homes very quickly, often within hours of being made available for adoption. And, the 12, 13, 14 year-old cats also find homes too, thanks to the big-hearted people in our community who make it their mission to provide a good home for one cat's twilight years. Pictured to the left are, five middle-aged "ladies" currently awaiting new homes:

- Seven-year-old **Tabby** ended up at PHS/SPCA when her owner died.
- **Garcia** is one groovy chick. At 6, she's barely middle-aged.
- **Gouda**, a four-year-old refined beauty, was surrendered to PHS/SPCA by her former owner.
- Oh-so-sweet **Yummy**, a former stray, is 5; she has at least five of her nine lives left.
- **Cora** just reached double digits; we call her a perfect 10!

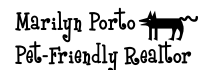

Disaster Planning for Your Pets

As many local residents will recall, PHS/SPCA was on scene in San Bruno within minutes of the terrible gas explosion and maintained a presence for days, assisting local pet owners in many ways. We provided food, water and welfare checks for pets left behind in the yards of evacuated homes, provided temporary sheltering for others at our shelter and gave free pet food and supplies to residents. PHS/SPCA was called to action once again, when coastal residents received an early morning tsunami warning on March 11, following the devastating earthquake in Japan. Fortunately, local residents weren't impacted, but our volunteers still mobilized and remained on the coast until the threat was downgraded. For large scale disasters, PHS/SPCA has four trailers like the one pictured below. They are positioned strategically in the northern, central, southern and coastal areas of our county; each has supplies that would enable us to set-up a temporary shelter for displaced pets.

The shelter urges all residents with pets to have their own emergency plan in place, including a place to stay if you need to leave your home, a way to transport your pet (crate for dogs, carrier for cats), and four days' worth of food, water, supplies and medications for your pet/s. A collar with current ID is also crucial should you ever be separated.
