Dog Training Classes

Agility: Fun class for active dogs who are led by their owners through obstacle course-like structures and activities. Next 6-week session begins: Sun., July 25, 10 am.

Puppy Preschool: for pups 2-4 months. Foundation for a lifetime of good habits. Includes basic commands (sit, down, stay, come, leash walking), correcting behaviors like biting, chewing, jumping, housebreaking, and socialization (off-leash playtime to teach puppies how to play long with other dogs) Next 6-week session begins: TBA.

Puppy Kindergarten: similar to Preschool, for pups 4-8 mos. Includes basic commands (sit, down, stay, come, leash walking), correcting behaviors such as biting, chewing, jumping, housebreaking, and socialization/off-leash play to teach pups how to play with other dogs. Next 6-week session begins: Wed., August 11, 6:15 pm (no class 9/1).

Puppy Playgroup: Held the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of every month at 6:15 pm for pups under 6 months who very much need socialization to build a good foundation for the future. Class provides off-leash, supervised playtime to teach puppies how to play with other dogs. Pups need not, but can be enrolled in one of the two classes above at the same time as this class.

Petite Pups Playgroup: Like our Puppy playgroup, but for dogs 6 mo+ and under 35 lbs. Next class begins Sun., July 18, 12:30 pm.

Companion Dog Level 1: Whether you've just adopted and want to get off on the right paw, or need a refresher, this class is for you. You will teach/master hand signals and commands (sit, down, come, heel, stay, leave it) and teach your dog to wait at doorways and walk politely on leash. Next 6-week session begins: Wed., August 11, 7:30 pm (no class 9/1).

Companion Dog Intermediate: for graduates of Puppy Classes, Companion Dog Level 1, or equivalent. Students work on heel, long down-stay, sit & down from a distance, come with distractions, voice control, and improve basic command response. Next 6-week session begins: Sat., September 11, 12 Noon (no class 9/18).

Companion Level 1 for Small Dogs: For dogs under 25 lbs and at least 6 mo. old. Basic obedience (sit, down, come, stay, leave it) plus specific challenges that small dog owners encounter such as housetraining, barking and safety. Next 6-week session begins: TBD.

Dog training for Kids: for 8-13 yr olds (must be accompanied by an adult). Learn to communicate with your dog and train your dog in basic obedience, while having fun together. Next session: TBA

Training Bully Breeds: for dogs at least 6 months old who are Pit Bulls, Staffordshire Terriers, Bull Terriers, or mixes of these breeds. Basic obedience plus breed history, early warning signs and body language. Offered the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month at 6:15 pm. Upcoming dates are August 24, September 14 and 28 and October 12. Structured group lesson plus guidance for individuals, depending on the week. Call ahead.

Tricks & Games: for graduates of Puppy Classes, Companion Dog Level 1, or equivalent. Enjoy fun time while teaching your dog fun tricks. Next 6-week session begins: TBA.

Beginner Clicker Training: Recommended for all dogs. Class will cover basic obedience (loose leash walking, sit, down, stay and come) and offer tips to build confidence of shy dogs. Next 6-week session begins: TBA

Canine Good Citizen: Certification program for dogs with consistent, good manners. Class to include: greeting friendly strangers, walking on loose leash, walking through a crowd, staying in place. Dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club. Next 7-week session begins: Sat., September 11, 1:15 pm (no class 9/18).

Dog Day Evenings: for dogs 6 mo+ and 40 lbs+. An off-leash, supervised socialization class offered the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of every month at 7:30 pm. Begins June 29.

Bully Breeds Playgroup: Off-leash play. Dogs must be social and owners must call ahead to schedule a dog evaluation. Next class begins: Thurs., July 15, 6 pm (no class 8/5).
